



## IV Certification:

### Intravenous Therapy in 2016

Learner outcome objectives:  
The participant will be able to:

1. Discuss legal aspects of intravenous therapy, to include BON standards, OSHA, INS and AVA guidelines
2. Identification and selection of appropriate veins for commonly used venipuncture sites and tips for hard to stick patients
3. Identify IV Therapy risks and complications and appropriate nursing interventions
4. Perform calculation of IV flow rates and identify appropriate pump
5. Demonstrate proper documentation of IV Therapy
6. Demonstrate IV Therapy Techniques
7. Define purposes of IV Therapy and define appropriate terms

The course will be 6 hours including lunch and breaks and you will receive Certification and CE form for the 6 CEs at the end of class. Extended times away from the class will be cause for incompleteness of course. Successful completion will include class participation, calculations exam of at least 80 and demonstration of proper IV start technique. Time will be allowed for practice and review of math formulas prior to exam.

Cost will be \$200 per participant and payment can be made by cash the day of class or credit card the day of class or in advance.
